

As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- 2) A cohabitation of fallen angels and women that produced a race of giants


Gen 6:1-2,4

And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they *were* fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same *became* mighty men which *were* of old, men of renown.

- The Lord did not give a clear reference in Luke 17:26-27 as to what occurred in Genesis 6:2, but he also didn't give a clear reference in Luke 17:28-29 to the homosexuality that certainly occurred in Sodom
- The term SONS OF GOD means “beings that are the product of a direct creative act of God”



As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- The nation of Israel is a son of God (Exo 4:22); Adam was a son of God before his fall (Luke 3:38); Christians are sons of God (John 1:12); and angels are sons of God (Job 1:6; 2:1; 38:7) cf. (Psa 89:6)
- The sons of God in Genesis 6:2 are ANGELS based on a comparison with 2 Peter 2:4 and Jude 6
- The fact they had illicit sexual relations with women is clear from Genesis 6:4

Gen 6:2,4

That **the sons of God** saw the daughters of men that they *were* fair; and **they took them wives** of all which they chose.

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when **the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men**, and they bare *children* to them, the same *became* mighty men which *were* of old, men of renown.


2 Pet 2:4

For if God spared not **the angels that sinned**, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Jude 6

And **the angels which kept not their first estate**, but **left their own habitation**, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot




- Jude 6 informs us that their sin involved not keeping their first “estate” and leaving their own “habitation”
 - ESTATE= “condition; rank; quality; state; order; class”
 - HABITATION= “an abode; residence”; the Greek word *oiketerion* appears only one other time in 2 Corinthians 5:2 where it is translated HOUSE and refers to our resurrection (glorified) bodies
 - These angels did not temporarily materialize as angels appear to have the ability to do with divine permission (Gen 19:1-3; Heb 13:2), but became flesh permanently, thus forfeiting their spiritual and immortal state
 - The word ALSO in Genesis 6:3 refers to the fact that these angels became FLESH, just a different flesh than that of man

Gen 6:3

And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

- These angels experienced what amounts to a “reverse Rapture”- instead of being translated UP, they came DOWN; instead of changing from mortal to immortal, they changed from immortal to mortal



As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- By forfeiting their immortality, they died like men in the Flood

Psa 82:6-7

I have said, **Ye are gods**; and all of you *are* children of the most High.

But ye shall **die like men, and fall** like one of the princes.


- After they died in the Flood, the spirits of these fallen angels were cast into hell for their sin, unlike the angels that fell with Lucifer (Rev 12:4) who are still free until the judgment (Rev 20:10)

2 Pet 2:4

For if God spared not **the angels that sinned**, but **cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment**;

Jude 6

And **the angels which kept not their first estate**, but **left their own habitation**, he hath **reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day**.



As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- These sons of God SAW the daughters of men, indicating they were of a class of angels called WATCHERS (Heb. iy^r) (Dan 4:13,17,23)
- The word TOOK in Genesis 6:2 is used in the sense of “to capture; to abduct; to seize; to carry away”, implying the women were not always willing but were raped (much like the alien abduction experience reported today)


Gen 6:2

That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they *were* fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

Dan 4:13

I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven;

- The context of both 2 Peter 2 and Jude connects the events of the days of Noah with those of the days of Lot
- Jude 6-7 equates the sin of the angels with the sin of Sodom and Gomorrah, which was FORNICATION and going after STRANGE FLESH

Gen 6:2,4

That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they *were* fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare *children* to them, the same *became* mighty men which *were* of old, men of renown.

2 Pet 2:4-7

For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth *person*, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;


And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked:

Jude 6-7

And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.


Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- Fornication is sexual relations between a man and a woman outside the divinely approved bounds of marriage
- Fornication between a man and a woman is a violation of God's law in ACT but not in kind
- The word STRANGE indicates that the fornication committed by both the Sodomites and the angels was not only a violation of God's law in act, but also in KIND
- STRANGE= "foreign; odd; unusual; not according to common way"
- The Greek word translated STRANGE is HETEROS (as in "heterosexual")
- In the Old Testament, the primary words translated STRANGER (Heb. Ger) and STRANGE (Heb. nokriy) are also translated ALIEN
- When the fallen angels came down they were probably viewed as the "gods" coming down from heaven or advanced beings from another world (today, they are called ALIENS)
- The word ALIEN appears 5x (Exo 18:3; Deu 14:21; Job 19:15; Psa 69:8; Isa 61:5); 5= # of DEATH
- Jude 7 has 35 words (7 x 5) and 170 letters (34 x 5); Jude is the 65th book of the Bible (13 x 5); 5= # of DEATH



As It Was In The Days Of Noah And Lot

- Regarding Sodom and Gomorrah, the strange flesh was men fornicating with men, and women with women
- Regarding the fallen angels, the strange flesh was angels fornicating not only with WOMEN, but also with MEN and ANIMALS
- This is why ALL flesh is said to have been corrupt and why ALL flesh (including the animals) was destroyed in the Flood, except those in the ark

1 Cor 15:39


All flesh is not the same flesh: but *there is* one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, and another of birds.

Gen 6:12,17; 7:23

And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein *is* the breath of life, from under heaven; *and* every thing that *is* in the earth shall die.

And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark.
