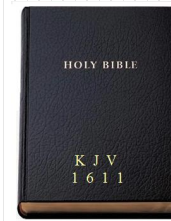

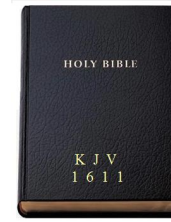

Jer 21:7

And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.

Jer 27:8,13

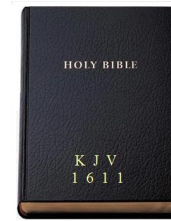
8 And it shall come to pass, *that* the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

13 Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?

Eze 14:21

For thus saith the Lord GOD; How much more when I send my four sore judgments upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast?

Rev 6:1-8

1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse that was red: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

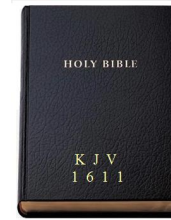
6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and *see* thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

- The three judgments brought by, and that follow, Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon are the same that are brought by, and that follow, the Antichrist
- Together with the king of Babylon, they constitute the four sore judgments

- The four sore judgments picture the first four seal judgments (i.e.- the “four horsemen of the Apocalypse”) in the Tribulation
- Historically, 2/3 of Judah died from the four sore judgments and 1/3 was scattered
- 1/4 of the earth is killed from the first four seal judgments during the first half of the Tribulation, but the Antichrist kills 2/3 of all Jews in the Tribulation and 1/3 is scattered (and eventually saved at the Second Coming of Christ)

Eze 5:12

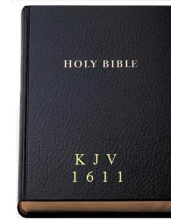
A third part of thee shall die with the pestilence, and with famine shall they be consumed in the midst of thee: and **a third part shall fall by the sword** round about thee; and **I will scatter a third part** into all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them.

Zec 13:8-9

8 And it shall come to pass, *that* in all the land, saith the LORD, **two parts therein shall be cut off and die**; but **the third shall be left** therein.

9 And **I will bring the third part through the fire**, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: **they shall call on my name**, and I will hear them: I will say, It *is* my people: and they shall say, The LORD *is* my God.

Jer 21:10

For I have set my face against this city for evil, and not for good, saith the LORD: **it shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon,** and **he shall burn it with fire.**

Jer 32:3

For Zedekiah king of Judah had shut him up, saying, Wherefore dost thou prophesy, and say, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, **I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon,** and **he shall take it;**

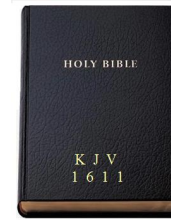
Jer 34:1-2

1 The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and all his army, and all the kingdoms of the earth of his dominion, and all the people, fought against **Jerusalem,** and against all the cities thereof, saying,

2 Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Go and speak to Zedekiah king of Judah, and tell him, Thus saith the LORD; Behold, **I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon,** and **he shall burn it with fire:**

- Jerusalem was given into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, to take and burn with fire
- Jerusalem will also be given over to the Antichrist, the king of Babylon the Great

Lam 1:10

The adversary hath spread out his hand upon all her pleasant things: for she hath seen *that* the heathen **entered into her sanctuary**, whom thou didst command *that* they should not enter into thy congregation.

Lam 4:12

The kings of the earth, and all the inhabitants of the world, would not have believed that **the adversary and the enemy** should have **entered into the gates of Jerusalem**.

Mic 1:9

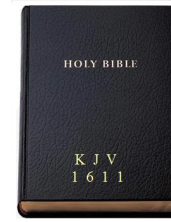
For her wound *is* incurable; for it is come unto Judah; **he is come unto the gate of** my people, *even* to **Jerusalem**.

Jer 46:13

The word that the LORD spake to Jeremiah the prophet, how Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon should come *and* smite the land of Egypt.

Eze 29:19-20

19 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will give the land of Egypt unto Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon; and he shall take her multitude, and take her spoil, and take her prey; and it shall be the wages for his army.

20 I have given him the land of Egypt for his labour wherewith he served against it, because they wrought for me, saith the Lord GOD.

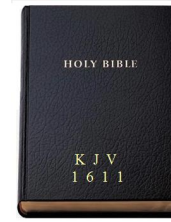
Eze 30:10-11,25

10 Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also make the multitude of Egypt to cease by the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon.

11 He and his people with him, the terrible of the nations, shall be brought to destroy the land: and they shall draw their swords against Egypt, and fill the land with the slain.

25 But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.

- Nebuchadnezzar, the king of Babylon, conquered Egypt and he and his people (i.e.- the Chaldeans) were called **THE TERRIBLE OF THE NATIONS**

Ezr 5:12

But after that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of **Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean**, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

Hab 1:6-8

6 For, lo, I raise up **the Chaldeans**, *that* bitter and hasty nation, which shall march through the breadth of the land, to possess the dwellingplaces *that are* not theirs.

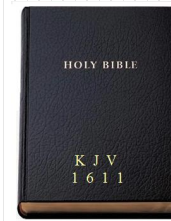
7 **They are terrible** and dreadful: their judgment and their dignity shall proceed of themselves.

8 Their horses also are swifter than the leopards, and are more **fierce** than the evening wolves: and their horsemen shall spread themselves, and their horsemen shall come from far; they shall fly as the eagle *that* hasteth to eat.

Isa 25:2-3

2 For thou hast made of a city an heap; *of* a defenced city a ruin: a palace of strangers to be no **city; it shall never be built.**

3 Therefore shall **the strong people** glorify thee, **the city of the terrible nations** shall fear thee.
