



# Bible Prophecy

Mystery, Babylon The Great



- 13) Tyre was destroyed in two stages separated by 240 years because it consisted of two separate but interdependent cities; and Babylon the Great will be destroyed in two stages separated by 3 ½ years and may consist of two separate but interdependent cities
  - The ancient city/state of Tyre consisted of a mainland city (Old Tyre) and an island city (New Tyre) built later about a half mile out from the mainland
  - When Nebuchadnezzar invaded the mainland city, many fled to the fortified island city for refuge





Eze 26:19

For thus saith the Lord GOD; When I shall make thee a desolate city, like the cities that are not inhabited; when **I** shall bring up the deep upon thee, and great waters shall cover thee;



 Nebuchadnezzar destroyed the mainland city but did not have a navy to attack the island city, so he set up

blockade to cut off

supply routes to the island

- The island city surrendered and agreed to pay tribute in 572 BC, 13 years after the siege began
- o The island city was destroyed 240 years later in 332 BC by Alexander the Great after a 7-month siege
- Alexander built a causeway out to the island city from the ruins of the old mainland city fulfilling Ezekiel 26:19



- Babylon the Great is destroyed in two stages from two different perspectives
- From one perspective, stage 1 could apply to the destruction of ancient Babylon that began with the conquest of the Medes and Persians (Dan 5:31) and was a partial fulfillment of the prophecies in Isaiah 13 and Jeremiah 50 and 51; and stage 2 could apply to the destruction of "new" Babylon in the Tribulation (Rev 17-18) and is a complete fulfillment of the prophecies in Isaiah 13 and Jeremiah 50-51
- o From another perspective, both stages of Babylon the Great's destruction take place during the Tribulation

#### **Stage 1: in the middle of the Tribulation by the 10 kings**

#### Rev 17:1-2,16-17

- 1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters:
- **2** With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
- **16** And **the ten horns** which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and **shall** make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and **burn her with fire**.
- 17 For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.



#### **Rev 18:8-9**

8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and **she shall be utterly burned with fire**: for strong *is* the Lord God who judgeth her.

**9** And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,

#### **Stage 2: at the end of the Tribulation by the Lord Jesus Christ**

#### Rev 16:17-19

17 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

**18** And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and <u>there was a great earthquake</u>, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great.

19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.



14) When judgment is completely fulfilled, both Tyre and Babylon the Great will be found no more at all and will never be built again

#### Eze 26:14,21


- **14** And I will make thee like the top of a rock: thou shalt be *a place* to spread nets upon; **thou shalt be built no more**: for I the LORD have spoken *it*, saith the Lord GOD.
- **21** I will make thee a terror, and **thou shalt be no more**: though thou be sought for, yet **shalt thou never be found again**, saith the Lord GOD.

#### **Rev 18:21**

And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall **that great city Babylon** be thrown down, and **shall be found no more at all**.

- Although the island city of Tyre was destroyed in 332 BC by Alexander the Great, it was rebuilt during the Roman period
- While it never regained its former prominence and prosperity, it is mentioned 12x in the NT (Matt 11:21-22; 15:21; Mark 3:8; 7:24,31; Luke 6:17; 10:13-14; Acts 12:20; 21:3,7), of which 8x refer to it as a contemporary city







- o Over time, landfill connected the former mainland and the island
- o Could this picture a connection between "Old Babylon" (Babylon" (Babylon" (Rome?) that has become visible over time?
- o Today, Tyre (Sur) is the fourth largest city in Lebanon (est. 117,000 people) behind Beirut, Tripoli, and Sidon
- Tyre will participate in the war of Psalm 83 (Psa 83:7) so her judgment is not yet completely fulfilled



## Additional truths about Tyre that may provide insight into Babylon the Great

• The PRINCE of Tyre is a type of the Antichrist

#### Eze 28:2,7-8

- **2** Son of man, say unto **the prince of Tyrus**, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thine heart *is* lifted up, and thou hast said, **I** *am* **a God**, **I sit** *in* **the seat of God**, **in the midst of the seas**; yet thou *art* a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:
- 7 Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and <u>they shall</u> <u>draw their swords</u> against the beauty of thy wisdom, <u>and they shall defile thy brightness</u>.
- 8 They shall bring thee **down to the pit**, and **thou shalt die** the deaths of *them that are* slain in the midst of the seas.
  - He professes to be DEITY (2 The 2:4; Rev 13:4)
  - o He sits in the SEAT OF GOD (Dan 11:45; 2 The 2:4)
  - He is SCARRED and SLAIN by a SWORD (Zec 11:17; Rev 13:3)
  - He goes down to THE PIT (Rev 17:8)
- If Tyre is a type of BABYLON THE GREAT (and the evidence supports this) and the Antichrist is the PRINCE of ROME (Dan 9:26-27), then Babylon the Great is the city of ROME



The KING of Tyre is SATAN

#### Eze 28:12-15

- 12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.
- 13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in the day that thou wast created.
- **14** Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.
- **15** Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till <u>iniquity was found in thee</u>.
- There is only one king of Tyre given by name (or title) and that is HIRAM (Huram), and he is associated with MASONS and MESSENGERS, who are HIS SERVANTS

#### 2 Sam 5:11

And Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and cedar trees, and carpenters, and masons: and they built David an house.
