


She hath sinned against the Lord.

- The ultimate root cause for any divine judgment is SIN
- This part of the prophecy applies to both the daughter of Babylon and the mother, Babylon the Great
- Two specific sins mentioned in Jeremiah 50-51 are PRIDE (v.29,31-32) and COVETEOUSNESS (51:13)

Why The Daughter Of Babylon And Babylon The Great Are Judged

- 1) For sinning against the Lord (v.14; Rev 18:5)- pride (v.29,31-32); covetousness (51:13)
- 2) As a recompense for their deeds (v.15,29; 51:6), especially persecution and execution of Jews (Psa 137:8; Isa 47:6; Jer 51:24,49)
- 3) For striving against the Lord (v.24)
- 4) For making all the earth drunken with her wine (i.e.-corruption; sorceries) (51:7)
- 5) For destroying the temple (51:11)
- 6) For destroying the earth (51:25)

Why The Daughter Of Babylon And Babylon The Great Are Judged (cont'd)

- 7) For the multitude of her sorceries and the great abundance of her enchantments (Isa 47:9; Rev 18:23)
- 8) For trusting in her wickedness (Isa 47:10)
- 9) For shedding the blood of the prophets and saints (Rev 17:6; 18:24; 19:2)

Shout against her round about...her walls are thrown down.

- This sounds like what happened to the city of JERICHO, which is a type of BABYLON THE GREAT

Jos 6:3-5

3 And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and **go round about the city** once. Thus shalt thou do six days.

4 And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

5 And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long *blast* with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, **all the people shall shout** with a great shout; and **the wall of the city shall fall down flat**, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.
