


Mystery, Babylon The Great

Jer 51:1

Thus saith the LORD; Behold, **I will raise up against Babylon**, and against **them that dwell in the midst of them** that rise up against me, **a destroying wind**;

I will raise up against Babylon...a destroying wind.

- The destroying WIND represents the SPIRIT of the kings of the Medes raised up against ancient Babylon (v.11) because WIND or BREATH represents the SPIRIT (Gen 2:7; Eze 37:9-14; John 3:8; Acts 2:2)
- THE SPIRIT of the kings of the Medes could refer to the SPIRITUAL principality over the Medes in high places (Dan 10:20; Eph 6:12)
- The armies of the Medes/Persians represents the armies of heaven composed of saints and angels (Isa 13:3) that comes against Babylon the Great at the Second Coming of Christ (Rev 19:11-14)
- The armies of the Lord are likened to a great WHIRLWIND because WHIRLWINDS are associated with JUDGMENT and the APPEARANCE OF THE LORD

Jer 25:30-33

30 Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread the grapes, against all the inhabitants of the earth.

31 A noise shall come *even* to the ends of the earth; for the LORD hath a controversy with the nations, he will plead with all flesh; he will give them that are wicked to the sword, saith the LORD.


32 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

33 And the slain of the LORD shall be at that day from one end of the earth even unto the other end of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.

Isa 66:15-16

15 For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

16 For by fire and by his sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be many.

Pro 1:27

Job 40:6


Then answered the LORD unto Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

Them that dwell in the midst of them.

- The second THEM refers to the BABYLONIANS, but who does the first THEM refer to who are IN THE MIDST of Babylon?
- Those IN THE MIDST of Babylon are also called THE MINGLED PEOPLE

Jer 50:37


A sword *is* upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all **the mingled people** that *are* **in the midst of her**; and they shall become as women: a sword *is* upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed.

- The MINGLED PEOPLE (i.e.- THEY who MINGLE themselves with the seed of men) are the supernatural 10 kings represented by the 10 toes on the image in Daniel 2, that rule with the Antichrist

Dan 2:42-43

42 And *as* **the toes** of the feet *were* part of iron, and part of clay, *so* the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken.

43 And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, **they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men**: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.

- Recall from previous lessons that the SONS OF GOD that MINGLED with the daughters of men in Genesis 6 are called THEY/THEM 4x (Gen 6:2,13)
- THE WATCHERS of Daniel 4 (Dan 4:17) are called THEY 6x (Dan 4:25-26,32)
- The WATCHERS of Jeremiah 4 (4:16) are called THEY (4:17) and they are EVIL, and come from THE NORTH (4:6) from a FAR COUNTRY (4:16)- they are also called MIGHTY MEN (5:15-16) cf. (Gen 6:4)
- The connection between (v.1; 50:37) seems to indicate that those IN THE MIDST of Babylon the Great are FALLEN SPIRITUAL beings that come to the earth in the Tribulation and mingle their DNA with human DNA
- This connection is completely lost in all the new bibles because the phrase IN THE MIDST OF THEM is changed to LEB-KAMAI, which is an English transliteration of the Hebrew phrase- Who would want to cover up this connection?


