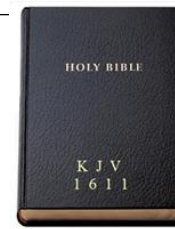
The Judgment Of Egypt

The Rapture

The Tribulation (Daniel's 70th Week; The time of JACOB'S trouble)



- *Italics* indicates events that may take place **before** the Rapture
- The fact any of these events **could** occur before the Rapture in no way undermines the doctrine of Imminency
- The same can be said of the prophecies related to the rebirth of Israel as a nation (Eze 37:7-8; Matt 24:32) fulfilled before the Rapture on May 14, 1948
- The Bible does not state any of these events **must** occur before the Rapture

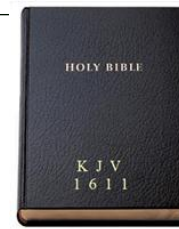

- **Syria** and **Egypt** are the only nations directly bordering Israel that are not specifically mentioned by common name or tribal name (i.e.- **Aram** and **Mizraim** respectively) in either Psalm 83 or Ezekiel 38
- Conditions concerning their judgment (Eze 28:24-26) will preclude them from participating in either conflict

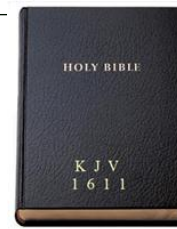
I. Biblical Names For Egypt

1. Egypt

- 1) Appears a total of 740x (a number divisible by 4, 5, and 10) in it's various forms, more than any other Gentile nation
 - *Egypt* appears 611x (47 x 13= # of REBELLION)
 - *Egyptian* appears 27x
 - *Egyptians* appears 98x
 - *Egyptian's* appears 4x
- 2) The first appearance is in reference to Abram going down to sojourn there due to a famine in the land

Gen 12:10

And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into **Egypt** to sojourn there; for the famine *was* grievous in the land.



The Judgment Of Egypt

2. Mizraim

- *Mizraim* appears 4x (Gen 10:6,13; 1 Chr 1:8,11)
- *Mizraim* is the tribal or patriarchal name for Egypt (Gen 10:6)
- *Abel-Mizraim* appears 1x (Gen 50:11)

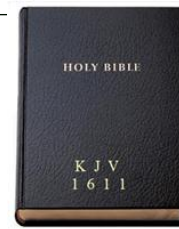
3. Rahab

- *Rahab* appears 10x but only three refer to Egypt (Psa 87:4; 89:10; Isa 51:9)
- *Rahab* = “proud; boaster; strength”; it is transliterated as a personification of PRIDE, representing Egypt

Psa 87:4

I will make mention of **Rahab** and Babylon to them that know me: behold Philistia, and Tyre, with Ethiopia; this *man* was born there.

- *Rahab* also refers to a DRAGON that represents Egypt cf. (Eze 29:3)



The Judgment Of Egypt

Psa 89:9-10

Thou rulest the raging of the sea: when the waves thereof arise, thou stillest them.

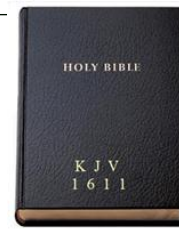
Thou hast broken **Rahab** in pieces, as one that is slain; thou hast scattered thine enemies with thy strong arm.

Isa 51:9

Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. *Art* thou not it that hath cut **Rahab**, and wounded **the dragon**?

4. Hagarenes/Hagarites?

- *Hagarenes* appears 1x (Psa 83:6)
- *Hagarites* appears 3x (1 Chr 5:10,19-20)
- The Hagarenes/Hagarites were descendants of the sons of ISHMAEL (Gen 25:13; 1 Chr 5:19), the son of HAGAR, the Egyptian
- The Hagarenes/Hagarites dwelt east of the Jordan river in GILEAD (at least during the days of Saul) (1 Chr 5:10)
- While the Hagarenes/Hagarites are at least partially EGYPTIAN (as descendants of Hagar) they are not necessarily synonymous with the nation of EGYPT



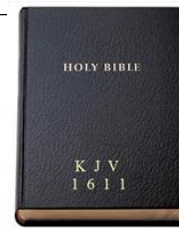

II. Biblical Geo-Politics Of Egypt

- The geography of Egypt has been consistent through the centuries

1. **Egypt In 1000 BC (Psa 83)**

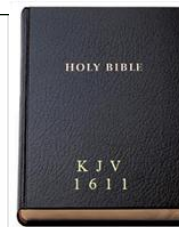
- Relations with Egypt are notably silent during the days of Saul and David
- Egypt was a place of refuge for enemies of David and Solomon, including Hadad (1 Kin 11:14-21) and Jeroboam (1 Kin 11:40)
- Solomon married Pharaoh's daughter (1 Kin 3:1) and Pharaoh gave the city of Gezer (which he previously conquered and burned) to his daughter as a wedding gift (1 Kin 9:16)
- Solomon maintained positive economic relations with Egypt (1 Kin 10:28)
- The Lord sent Shishak, king of Egypt, to invade Jerusalem in the days of Rehoboam and take many of the temple treasures to Egypt as a form of judgment (1 Kin 14:22-26)



The Judgment Of Egypt

2. Egypt In 600 BC (Eze 38)

- Israel trusted on Egypt to help them against the impending Assyrian threat rather than trusting the Lord (Isa 30:1-7; 31:1-3)
- Judah was tempted to trust in Egypt against the impending Assyrian invasion of Jerusalem (2 Kin 18:21,24)
- Pharaoh-necho killed Josiah at Megiddo for meddling in his war with the Assyrians (2 Kin 23:29)
- Pharaoh-necho subjected Israel to tribute in the days of Jehoahaz and Jehoiakim (2 Kin 23:33-35)
- Egypt came forth to help Judah against the invading Babylonians but turned back (Jer 37:5-7) cf. (2 Kin 24:7)
- Many Jews fled to Egypt in fear of the Babylonians (2 Kin 25:26)
- Faithless people dragged Jeremiah down to Egypt with them against the counsel of the Lord (Jer 42:13-22; 43:1-7)
