

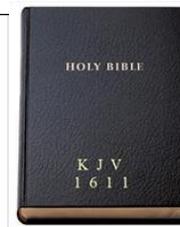



Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations


IV. Ammon (Northern Jordan)

1. The Passages

- 1) Jeremiah 25:15,21; 49:1-6
- 2) Ezekiel 25:1-7
- 3) Daniel 11:41
- 4) Amos 1:13-15
- 5) Zephaniah 2:8-11


2. The Prophecies

- The Ammonites will expand their borders to include Gad (Jer 49:1) and will do so by ripping up pregnant women living in Gilead (Amo 1:13)




Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations

- Ammon will drink of the cup of God's wrath (Jer 25:15,21)
- Ammon will be judged for rejoicing over the profaning of the temple and captivity of the Jews at the hands of the Babylonians (Eze 25:3,6), for reviling and reproaching Israel, and for encroaching on Israel's borders (Zep 2:8,10)
- An alarm of war will be heard in Rabbah (i.e.- the capital city of Amman and present day city of Amman) (Jer 49:2)
- The women shall be burned with fire and cry as they run about (Jer 49:2-3)
- Rabbah will be destroyed by fire (Amo 1:14) and become a desolate heap (Jer 49:2)
- This will take place during a day of battle and a whirlwind (Amo 1:14)
- The Ammonites will be spoiled (Jer 49:3; Eze 25:7; Zep 2:9)
- The political and religious leaders of Ammon shall go into captivity together (Jer 49:3; Amo 1:15)
- The Lord will bring a fear upon Ammon from the nations around them (Jer 49:5)



Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations

- The Ammonites will be displaced and become refugees (Jer 49:5)
- Ammon will be cut off and destroyed (Eze 25:7)
- Ammon will perish from among the countries (Eze 25:7)
- Ammon will become a perpetual desolation like Gomorrah (Zep 2:9)
- The Lord will destroy the gods of the earth (including Allah) and men shall worship him (Zep 2:11)
- The Ammonites will know that the Lord is God when they are judged (Eze 25:5,7) cf. (Psa 83:18; Eze 28:24)
- Israel will not only re-possess the tribal inheritance of Gad but will also expand it's borders to include the land of Ammon (Jer 49:2; Eze 25:4; Zep 2:9)
- Ammon, along with Moab and Edom (the other nations that make up current day Jordan), will escape being conquered by the Antichrist (Dan 11:41) because it will be a place of refuge for fleeing Jews in the second half of the Tribulation
- The Lord will return the captivity of Ammon (Jer 49:6)
