

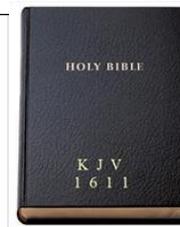




# Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations

## **VI. Edom (Southern Jordan)**

### **1. The Passages**

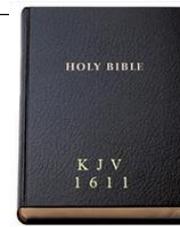
- 1) Numbers 24:18

# Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations


## 2. The Prophecies

- Edom will drink of the cup of God's wrath (Jer 25:15,21; 49:12)
- Edom will be judged for their perpetual hatred of Israel (Eze 35:5,11) as evidenced by: (1) their refusal to help Israel when they came out of Egypt (Num 20:20; Amo 1:11); (2) their vengeance upon Israel (Eze 25:12); (3) their killing of Jews as they attempted to flee the Babylonian invasion (Eze 35:5; Oba 10-14); and (4) their blasphemous pledge to possess the land of Israel (Eze 35:10,12)
- The other nations in Psalm 83 turn against Edom at the border of Israel (Oba 7) (and start fighting each other cf. Psa 83:9,13,17)
- The Lord will use Israel as his instrument of judgment upon Edom (Eze 25:14; Oba 18)
- Edom will be made to flee (from before Israel?) (Jer 49:19)
- The judgment of Edom will come from the air (the Israeli Air Force?) and their armies will panic in fear when they see it (Jer 49:22)
- Edom will be destroyed by fire (Amo 1:12) from Israel (Oba 18)




## Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations

- Dedan (i.e.- Saudi Arabia) will suffer calamity and casualties as a result of their alliance with Teman and will be forced to flee from them (Isa 21:13-15; Jer 49:7-8; Eze 25:13)
- There will not be any men or beasts remaining in Edom (Jer 49:10; Eze 25:13; Oba 9,18) Cont: (Isa 17:6; Jer 46:26; 48:47; 49:6,39)
- Mt. Seir will be filled with the bodies of their slain men (Eze 35:8)
- Edom, Mt. Seir, and all their cities will be desolate and a perpetual waste (Jer 49:17,20; Eze 35:3-4,7,9,14-15; Oba 10) from Bozrah in the north (Jer 49:13) to Teman in the south (Eze 25:13) cf. (Amo 1:12)
- The destruction and desolation of Edom will be like the judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah (Jer 49:18) and ancient Babylon cf. (Jer 50:40)-complete and permanent, no one shall ever live there again
- Mt. Seir will know that the Lord is God when it is judged (Eze 35:9,12,15) cf. (Psa 83:18; Eze 28:24)
- Israel will possess Edom (Oba 17,19) cf. (Num 24:18; Amo 9:12)



## Judgment Of The Psalm 83 Nations

- Edom, along with Ammon and Moab (the other nations that make up current day Jordan), will escape being conquered by the Antichrist (Dan 11:41) because it will be a place of refuge for fleeing Jews in the second half of the Tribulation (Psa 60:8-9)
- The sword of God's judgment will come upon Idumea at the Second Coming of Christ (Isa 34:5,8; 63:1,4)
- There will be a great sacrifice and slaughter in Bozrah (Isa 34:6-7) as the Lord destroys the armies of the Antichrist (Isa 63:2-3,5-6) surrounding the Jewish remnant which have taken refuge in Edom (Psa 60:8-9)
- The streams and land of Idumea will be turned into a lake of fire and it will be desolate and waste forever (Isa 34:9-10; Joel 3:19)
- Idumea will become a habitation of unclean spirits (Isa 34:11-15)
