




 - 2) A nation located far west from Israel
 - 3) A nation with a coastline on at least two opposite sides of it's land mass
 - 4) A nation that is heedless and negligent
 - 5) A nation that dwells quietly and securely
 - 6) A nation that has a large amount of land, land that is very good, and where there is no want
 - 7) A nation that is at ease and without trouble
 - 8) A nation given to pleasures



- Judges 18 is about “pilgrims” from the tribe of Dan who are looking for a new land (Jud 18:1) and a fresh start
- The land the Danites settled in was one in which the natives dwelt without a care; a land that was quiet and secure, very good, large; and a place where there was no want of any thing that is in the earth (Jud 18:7,9-10)
- The Danites slaughtered the natives and burnt their homes to possess the land (Jud 18:27), and proceeded to name the capital city of their new land after “the father of their country” (Jud 18:29)

- The Danites set up an idolatrous worship system in the new land to rival the true worship of the Lord at Shiloh, until the judgment of the captivity of the northern tribes (Jud 18:30-31)
- The founding and history of the USA progressed down two parallel, but diametrically opposed, paths- one based on Biblical Christianity that the Lord sowed, the other on the occult and ancient mystery religions (e.g.- Catholicism and Masonry) that Satan concurrently sowed
 - Most of the founding fathers of the USA were MASONS
 - The capital city named after the “father of our country” is located in the District of COLUMBIA, between the states of MARYland and VIRGINia, indicating a dedication to the “queen of heaven” (Jer 44:17)
 - Images of the queen of heaven sit atop the US Capitol Dome, outside the Supreme Court building (dual images of “Lady Justice”), and in New York harbor (“Lady Liberty”)
 - The Washington Monument and US Capitol building are a match set to the obelisk (i.e.- phallic symbol) and dome (i.e.- symbol of the womb) located in the Vatican at Rome

- The “wheat and the tares” that these two opposing paths represent will dwell together in the land until “the harvest” of judgment
- True born again Christians (the wheat) will be gathered into heaven and the lost (the tares) will be judged by fire

Matt 13:24-30

Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:

But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way.


But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also.

So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares?

He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up?

But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them.

Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.
