
Inspiration & Preservation



I) PRE-REQUISITES OF PRESERVATION



Revelation = "the unveiling of something previously hidden so that it may be seen for what it is; the act of disclosing to others what was before unknown to them; the disclosure or communication of truth to men by God"





1) GENERAL (NATURAL) REVELATION 2) SPECIAL REVELATION

- Accessible to ALL people equally at ALL times
- Bears witness to the PRESENCE and POWER of God
- Objective is to CONDEMN man and show him his NEED for God

- Accessible to SPECIFIC people at VARIOUS times and in VARIOUS ways
- Bears witness to the PERSONALITY and PLAN of salvation of God
- Objective is to CONVERT man and bring him NEAR to God



1) GENERAL (NATURAL) REVELATION 2)

- Creation (Psa 19:1-4; Rom 1:20)
- Conscience (Rom 1:19; 2:15)

2) SPECIAL REVELATION

- Audible Voice (Gen 2:16-17)
- Visions (Gen 15:1)
- Dreams (Gen 20:3)
- Angels (Gen 19:1)
- Urim (1 Sam 28:6)
- Prophets (Heb 1:1)
- Jesus Christ (John 1:14)- the crown of revelation
- Scripture (2 Tim 3:16-17) the completion of revelation



Revelation = Divine **DISCLOSURE**

Scripture = Divine **DOCUMENTATION**

Inspiration = Divine DIRECTION

Preservation = **Divine DEFENSE**

Illumination = Divine DISCOVERY
