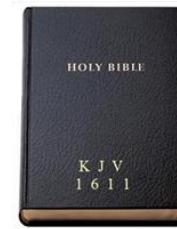
- Every time angels appear they look like men (18:2; 19:1,15-16; Dan 9:21; 10:5; Matt 28:2; Mark 16:5; Luke 24:4,23; Heb 13:2; Rev 21:17)
- Both angels (v.8; 19:3; Psa 78:25) and the Lord can eat (18:8; Exo 24:11; Mark 14:18; Luke 22:16; 24:42-43; John 21:12; Rev 3:20)
- The Lord will give a man illumination in his word who: (1) brings up his children in the way of the Lord (18:19; Eph 6:4); and (2) is willing to teach others (18:19; 2 Tim 2:2)

The Testimony Of Noah vs. Lot

1. Noah's testimony was POWERFUL; Lot's was PATHETIC
2. Noah's testimony was EFFECTIVE; Lot's was DEFECTIVE
3. Noah's testimony was that he "walked with God" (6:9); Lot's was that he walked with wicked men and sinners (13:13)

5. Zoar

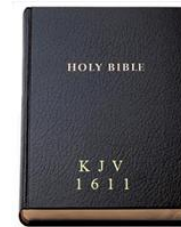
Description Of The Destruction Of Sodom And Gomorrah

- Fire and brimstone
- Complete overthrow
- All the inhabitants killed
- All that grew upon the ground destroyed
- Smoke like a great furnace ascending to heaven

NOTE: This description resembles that of a nuclear explosion

Similarities Of Lot And Noah

1. Both lived in days characterized as typical of the days directly preceding the Second Coming of Christ (Luke 17:26-32)
2. Both are types of the Tribulation saint preserved through the judgment of God (Heb 11:7; 2 Pet 2:7-8)
3. Both are part of eight people God intended on sparing from judgment (19:14-16; 1 Pet 3:20; 2 Pet 2:5)
4. Both are last seen in the wake of a drunken stupor that included involuntary incestuous relations (19:32-36; 9:21-24)
