

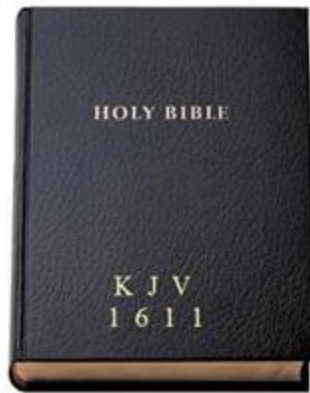

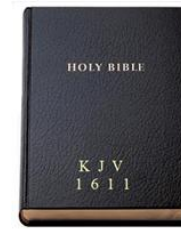

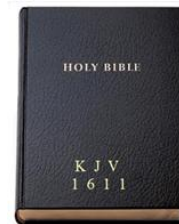
Genesis 25 = Isaac's BOYS:The Sold BIRTHRIGHT

Definitions Of Names

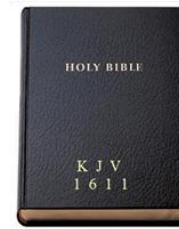
- *Esek* = “contention” (26:20)
- *Sitnah* = “hatred” (26:21)
- *Rehoboth* = “enlargement” (26:22)
- *Beer-sheba* = “well of the oath or covenant” (26:28,33)
- *Beth-el* = “the house of God” (28:17,19)

1. Sense of sight (v.1)
2. Sense of touch (v.22)
3. Sense of hearing (v.22)
4. Sense of taste (v.25)
5. Sense of smell (v.27)

Rebekah's Plan To Secure The Blessing For Jacob

1. She will deceive Isaac's sense of taste by dressing goat meat as venison (27:9-10)
2. She will deceive Isaac's sense of smell and touch by dressing Jacob as Esau (27:11-17)

The 5 Lies Of Jacob

1. "I am Esau thy firstborn" (27:19)
2. "I have done as thou badest me" (27:19)
3. "...eat of my venison" (27:19)
4. "Because the LORD thy God brought it to me" (27:20)
5. "I am (Esau)" (27:24)
