“Be Fruitful And Multiply”: A Commission To The HEAD Of A Race

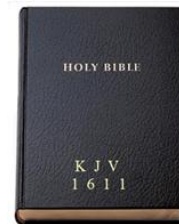
1. Adam (1:22,28) = the head of HUMANITY
 2. Noah (9:1) = the head of the GENTILES
 3. Jacob (35:11) = the head of the JEWS
- *Beth-el* = “house of God”; it is the place where God appears TO us (35:9) and speaks WITH us (35:15); it is a place we ought to GO UP TO and DWELL (35:1)
- Our PUBLIC Beth-el is where we go to church and our PRIVATE Beth-el is where we have our personal devotions

Facts About Death

1. DEFINITION of death= the separation of the soul (and spirit) from the body (35:18) cf. (Jam 2:26)
2. DESTINATION at death = the departure of the soul and spirit to either heaven or hell (the body goes to the grave) (35:18) cf. (Phl 1:23)

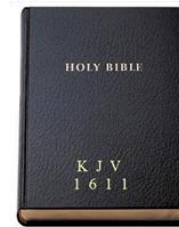


Notes Of Interest Regarding Jacob's Return To Isaac

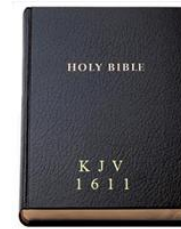
1. Isaac had moved from Beer-sheba (28:10) to Hebron since Jacob left 20 years earlier
 2. Isaac never got to meet Rachel since she died on the way
 3. There is no mention of Rebekah because she had apparently died by this time
-
- ESAU is the PERSON; EDOM the PLACE (36:1)
 - Esau had 5 sons (36:10,14) of which 3 were dukes (36:18)
 - Esau had 11 grandsons who were dukes (36:15-17)
 - First appearance of *Amalek* (36:12), a grandson of Esau, whose descendants would be the first antagonists of the nation of Israel (Exo 17:8)
 - Esau's family mingled with the family of Seir the Horite to form the nation of Edom (36:20-39)
 - The 7 sons of Seir were also dukes (36:29-30) and there were 8 successive kings in the land (36:31-39)

Joseph, The Great Type Of Jesus Christ

1. A shepherd (37:2) cf. (John 10:11)
2. His father loved him above all (37:3) cf. (Matt 3:17)
3. His brethren hated him without a cause (37:4-5,8) cf. (John 15:25)
4. His father sent him to his brethren (37:13-14) cf. (Luke 20:13)
5. His brethren plotted to kill him (37:20) cf. (Mark 12:7; John 11:53)
6. His brethren stripped him of his coat (37:23) cf. (John 19:23)
7. His brother Judah sold him out (37:27) cf. (Matt 26:14-15)
8. Sold for the price of a slave (37:28) cf. (Matt 26:15)
9. Taken to Egypt (37:28) cf. (Matt 2:14-15)
10. His brethren conspired to cover up the truth about his missing body (37:31-32) cf. (Matt 28:12-15)
