

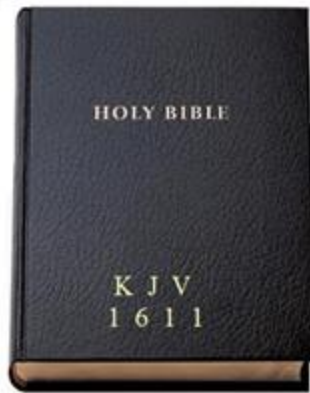

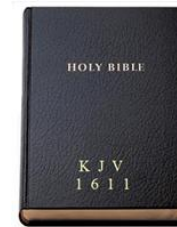

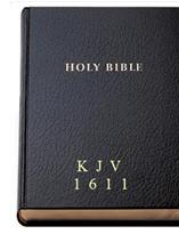


JOSEPH: THE PROVIDER

Joseph, The Great Type Of Jesus Christ

1. God was with him in everything he did (39:2-3,21-23) cf. (John 16:32)
 2. He was well favored (39:6) cf. (Luke 2:52)
 3. He was severely tempted (39:7-12) cf. (Matt 4:1-11)
 4. He was falsely accused (39:17-18) cf. (Matt 26:59-61)
 5. He was silent before his accusers (39:19-20) cf. (Isa 53:7)
 6. He was condemned with two prisoners, one who would be saved and the other lost (40:2-3) cf. (Luke 23:32,39-41)
 7. He was associated with the fruit of the vine (the butler) (40:9-11) and bread (the baker) (40:16-17) in his suffering cf. (Matt 26:26-29)
- If there was ever a person besides the Lord Jesus who had reason to DOUBT and to POUT over his circumstances, it was Joseph, yet he had the SHOUT- there was no need to WAIL because God did not BAIL and would not FAIL
