

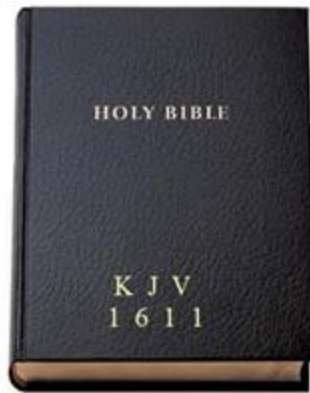

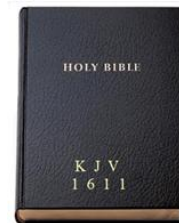

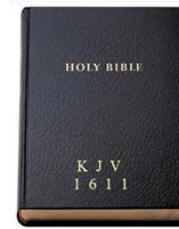


JOSEPH: THE PROVIDER

Tokens Of Joseph's Promotion (41:42-43)

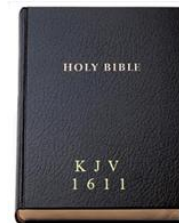
1. Pharaoh's RING is placed upon him
2. A change in RAIMENT
3. A gold chain is placed upon his neck
4. He is made to RIDE in the second chariot
5. A decree is made to bow the knee to him

The Changes In Joseph's Circumstances

1. A change in his OCCUPATIONAL status- he goes from PRISONER to PRIME MINISTER
 2. A change in his SOCIAL status- he has a new LIFE as Zaphnath-paaneah
 3. A change in his MARITAL status- he has a new WIFE, Asenath
- How did Potiphar (who sent Joseph to prison) and his wife (whose false accusations led to Joseph's imprisonment) react to the news of his promotion?



Gen 41-43



- *Zaphnath-paaneah* = “revealer of secret things”
- *Asenath* = “she who is of Neith” (an Egyptian goddess)
- *Manasseh* = “forgetting”
- *Ephraim* = “fruitful”

Joseph, The Great Type Of Jesus Christ

1. He was highly exalted after his suffering (41:41) cf. (Phl 2:9-11)
2. He married a Gentile bride (41:45) cf. (Eph 3:6; 5:31-32)
3. He was 30 years old when he began his “ministry” (41:46) cf. (Luke 3:23)
4. All nations came to him (41:57) cf. (Isa 2:2-3; Zec 14:16) for bread cf. (John 6:35)
5. He was unknown to his brethren for a period of time (42:7-8) cf. (Rom 10:3-4; 11:25)
