Survey Of The Bible I

Genesis-Deuteronomy



Exo 5-6

- **The 1st Demand (5:1)**
- Moses SUBTRACTS the following phrases from the word of God, “Israel is my son, even my firstborn” and “if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn” (5:1) cf. (4:22-23)
- Moses ADDS the phrase, “lest he fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword” to the word of God (3:18) cf. (5:3) thus changing the meaning of WHO will reap negative consequences if Pharaoh does not obey the Lord
- Pharaoh’s actions in (5:7-9) pictures Satan getting lost sinners so busy in worldly lusts and labors that they do not have time to think about their eternal souls and spiritual needs
- A principle from Exodus 5 is that idleness of mind and/or body leads to WHINING (5:8) and WRONG DOING (5:17); and the remedy is WORK (5:9,18)
- Moses blames the Lord for the contrary results but it was HIS fault for not preaching the word of God that was given to him (5:23)

The 7 “I Will” Promises (6:6-8)

1. I WILL bring you out from under the burdens
2. I WILL rid you out of their bondage
3. I WILL redeem you with a stretched out arm
4. I WILL take you to me for a people
5. I WILL be to you a God
6. I WILL bring you in unto the land
7. I WILL give it you for an heritage

- The Lord reminds Moses to SPEAK ALL that he told him to (6:29; 7:2) just as he reminded him to DO ALL that he told him to in (4:21)
