

Survey Of The Bible I

Genesis-Deuteronomy

Exo 13-15



- Since the Lord spared all the firstborn of the children of Israel from the destroyer, all the firstborn of man and beast were to be sanctified to the Lord
- The word SANCTIFY (13:2) is defined as SET APART (13:12) and SACRIFICE (13:15); and is derived from the same Hebrew word translated HOLY cf. (Lev 20:8,24,26)
- The sanctification was made effective by repeating the redemptive act of the passover, namely, the shed blood of a lamb (13:13)
- The way the Lord leads us may not be the shortest way or the easiest way, but it is the right way and the best way for us spiritually (13:17)

Egypt and Sinai, 1400 to 1200 B.C.





Exo 13-15

- The standard Egyptian chariot had up to three men, the charioteer, the warrior, and the captain (14:7), and was drawn by two horses
- Pharaoh's chariot was manned by him alone; the reins were fastened around his waist so his hands were free to use weapons
- Although a man is saved by the blood of the Lamb (12:23) and no longer of the world (12:51), Satan will still pursue him to destroy his life (14:8) cf. (1 Pet 5:8)
- When the children of Israel find themselves between the Red sea and Pharaoh's army, they fear and lose faith (14:10)- this is the first of 10x the children of Israel "tempt" the Lord cf. (Num 14:22)
- During these times they CRIED (14:10-12), MURMURED (15:24), CHIDED (17:2), COMPLAINED (Num 11:1), and WEPT (Num 11:4)
- Their attitude was "it is better to live for the devil than to die for the Lord"; and "it is better to live as a slave than to die a free man"
- The purpose of the "baptism unto Moses" (14:19-22; 1 Cor 10:1-2) was to SEE the salvation of the Lord cf. (1 Pet 3:21)
- The pillar of the cloud and the pillar of fire was the ANGEL OF GOD

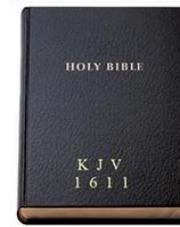

- The pillar of the cloud came between the Egyptians and the children of Israel meaning Pharaoh would have to go through the Lord to get at the children of Israel
 - The PILLAR was God giving his children PROTECTION from DESTRUCTION; the PARTING was God giving his children PROVISION for DELIVERANCE
 - The Lord sent a strong east wind to gradually part the Red sea over a period of about 6-12 hours (14:21)
 - The waters were a wall on either side and the ground was completely dry, not even the sand and stones were wet (14:22)
 - The destruction of the Egyptians in the Red sea is a type of the destruction of the Gentile powers at Armageddon (14:24,27,30) cf. (Mal 4:2; Mark 13:35; Rom 11:26)
 - Such a shameful defeat at the hand of slaves would not be recorded in the annals of Egyptian history- the destruction at the Red sea marked the end of the Egyptian empire

- The Red sea crossing was Israel's BAPTISM (1 Cor 10:2), which followed their REDEMPTION by the blood of the lamb
- Pharaoh, a type of Satan, pursued the redeemed in an attempt to bring them back into Egypt to SERVE him (14:5), or kill them if they refused
- He brought fear to their hearts as they approached their "baptism", and Satan does the same with new Christians
- He knows baptism is a public testimony of salvation and the first act of obedience- if he can prevent the new Christian from taking this step, he can probably get him back into the world
