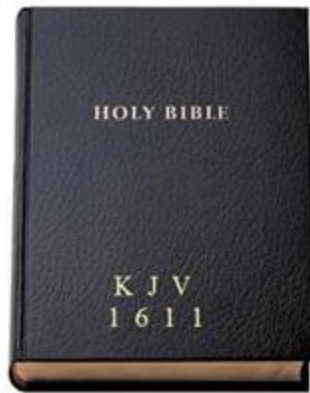

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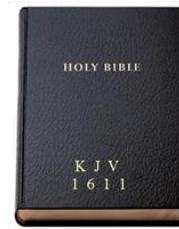

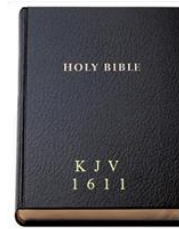


Lev 26-27

Blessings Conditioned Upon Obedience

1. Fruitfulness and prosperity in the land (26:4-5)
 2. Safety and peace in the land (26:5-6)
 3. No fear (26:6)
 4. Evil beasts removed from the land (26:6)
 5. The sword removed from the land (26:6)
 6. Enemies will flee and fall (26:7-8)
 7. Respect and residence from the Lord (26:9-12)
-
- DESPISING the word of God is mentioned 14x (26:15, 43; Num 15:31; 2 Sam 12:9; 2 Chr 36:16; Pro 1:30; 13:13; 19:16; Isa 5:24; 30:12; Eze 20:13; 16, 24; Amo 2:4)
 - A total of five progressive chastisements are promised for disobedience; the first consisting of seven components (26:16-17), with the next four indicated by the phrase, SEVEN TIMES (MORE) (26:18,21,24,28)
 - The phrase SEVEN TIMES may apply prophetically to the 7-year Tribulation, when Israel will “pass under the rod” (Eze 20:37) and “seven times” (years) will pass over him (Dan 4:16)





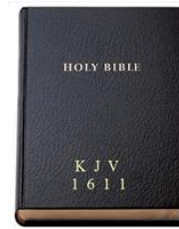
Lev 26-27

- The Jehovah's Witnesses originally "prophesied" that Armageddon would occur in 1914 based on the phrase, SEVEN TIMES
- They multiplied 360 (the number of days in the Jewish year) by 7 (because of the phrase SEVEN TIMES) to get 2,520 days; then converted these days to years based on the "each day for a year" formula (Num 14:34; Eze 4:6)
- Then they added the 2,520 years to 606 BC (the year of the first deportation to Babylon) to get 1914 AD
- When the world did not end and Jesus did not return and set up the kingdom, even after World War I (the war to end all wars), the Jehovah's Witnesses were forced to say that Jesus returned INVISIBLY in 1914 and began ruling through the Watch Tower Society

The 7 Components Of The First Chastisement (26:16-17)

1. Terror attacks
2. Consumption (a disease of the lungs)
3. A burning ague (a fever)
4. Enemies shall eat the fruit of the land
5. Slain by enemies
6. Ruled by enemies
7. Flee even though no one pursues





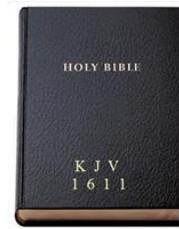
Lev 26-27

- **The Second Chastisement:** The land will not yield her increase (26:18-20)
- **The Third Chastisement:** Wild beasts will invade the land (26:21-22)
- **The Fourth Chastisement:** The sword will be brought upon the land; pestilence will be sent; and deliverance into the hand of the enemy (26:23-26)

The 7 Components Of The Fifth Chastisement (26:29-33)

1. Children to be cannibalized
 2. High places and images destroyed
 3. Abhorred of the Lord
 4. Cities to be wasted
 5. Sanctuaries made desolate
 6. The land made desolate
 7. The people dispersed among the heathen
- The condition of the Jews of the dispersion (i.e.- Gr. *Diaspora*) (70 AD- 1948 AD) is described in (26:36-39)
 - One of the root causes of dispersion would be violating the sabbath of the land (26:34-35) cf. (25:2-4; 2 Chr 36:21)





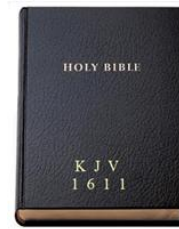

- The three-fold condition for forgiveness (26:40-42) is: (1) confession; (2) humbleness; and (3) acceptance of punishment cf. (2 Chr 7:14)

The Estimation Of Dedicated Persons (27:3-7)		
Age	Male	Female
1 Month- 5 Years	5 shekels of silver	3 shekels of silver
5 Years- 20 Years	20 shekels of silver	10 shekels of silver
20 Years- 60 Years	50 shekels of silver	30 shekels of silver
60 Years- Older	15 shekels of silver	10 shekels of silver

- Adulthood and minimum military age was 20 years old while the maximum working age was 60 years old (27:3)
- Judas betrayed the Lord Jesus Christ for 30 pieces of silver- the price of a female servant (27:4) cf. (Matt 26:15)
- Joseph was sold for 20 pieces of silver to the Ishmeelites because he was 17 years old at the time (27:5) cf. (Gen 37:2,28)

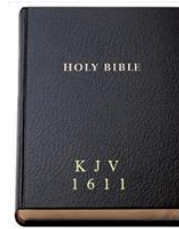




Lev 26-27

- **PASSETH UNDER THE ROD** = the method of tithing the herd or flock; the animals passed through a gate, one by one, with a person standing by with an outstretched rod, colored by an iron pigment; the person counted and touched every tenth animal with his rod **marking** it cf. (Psa 44:22; Isa 6:13; Isa 10:5; Eze 20:37; Mic 7:14)

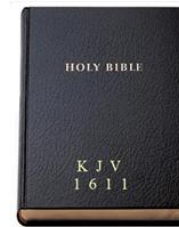
- The world will be judged one day based on what is recorded in the Lord's BOOKS (Rev 20:12), and some will even question (judge) the Lord's facts (Rom 3:4)
- *Numbers*, along with *1 Chronicles*, demonstrates that the Lord gives great attention to detail even if it seems trivial to us
- *Numbers* resumes historically where *Exodus* ended
- *Leviticus* emphasizes the believer's WORSHIP, PURITY, and POSITION; while *Numbers* emphasizes his WALK, PILGRIMAGE, and PROGRESS
- The word NUMBER(S) appears 127x

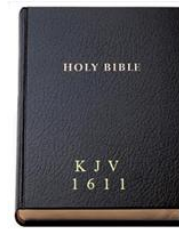

- TWENTY YEARS OLD AND UPWARD is defined as MILITARY AGE (1:3)
- The Levites were not numbered because they were exempt from MILITARY service due to their MINISTRY service (1:47-51)
- It was a capital crime for anyone other than a Levite to take down or set up the tabernacle (1:51)
