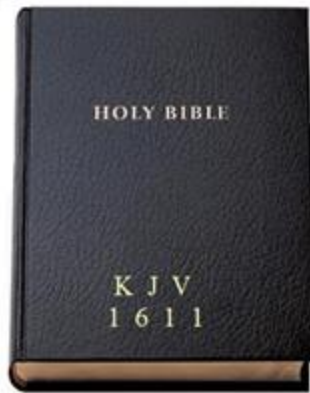

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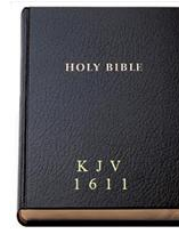

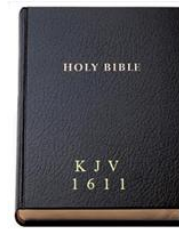
Genesis-Deuteronomy



Deu 3-6

- EDREI (3:10)= a companion city to Ashtaroth in Bashan (1:4); Ashtaroth was associated with GIANTS (3:11,13; Gen 14:5) and the worship of the “queen of heaven”
 - Og was the last of the remnant of the giants IN BASHAN (3:11,13), and his bed was 13.5’ long and 6.0’ wide
 - Bashan was considered THE LAND OF THE GIANTS at one time (3:13)
 - JORDAN (3:27)= a type of the VICTORIOUS CHRISTIAN LIFE; the law (typified by MOSES) cannot bring victory into the life of a Christian, it can only come by Jesus Christ (typified by JOSHUA)
 - Three times a warning is given regarding adding/taking away from the word of God: (1) at the beginning of the Bible (4:2); in the middle of the Bible (Pro 30:6); and (3) at the end of the Bible (Rev 22:18-19)
 - Adding and subtracting from the word of God changes it; if it is changed, it cannot be kept; if it is not kept, there will be judgment
 - The sin and judgment of Baal-peor, mentioned in the context of adding and taking away from the word of God (4:2-3), illustrates this cf. (Num 25:3-4,9)
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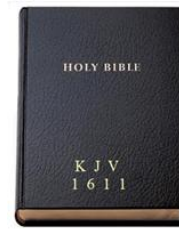

- Cleaving to the Lord (4:4) would, therefore, be comparable to not adding or taking away from the word of God
- Parents and grandparents are responsible for teaching their children and grandchildren the word of God so they will learn the fear of the Lord (4:9-10) cf. (6:2,7)
- THE IRON FURNACE (4:20)= refers to EGYPT but also points to the gas chambers of Nazi Germany

Similarities Between The Events Of The Exodus and World War II

1. Pharaoh was not a native Egyptian (he was ASSYRIAN) (Isa 52:4) and Hitler (the Fuhrer) was not a native German (he was AUSTRIAN)
 2. Israel became a nation around the time of Pharaoh's defeat and death (Exo 19:6), and became a nation again around the time of Hitler's defeat and death (May 14, 1948)
 3. Israel had battles with CANAANITES (occupiers of the land) after the Exodus and with PALESTINIANS (occupiers of the land) after WWII
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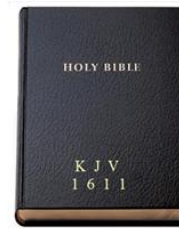

- If the words CONSUMED (4:24) and DESTROYED (4:26) equate to being ANNIHILATED as some falsely teach, then how could Israel be LEFT FEW IN NUMBER (4:27)? If they were annihilated, there would be NONE left in number
 - WHEN THOU ART IN TRIBULATION...IN THE LATTER DAYS (4:30)= Israel's history is one of tribulation, but in the latter days they will go through THE Tribulation (Jer 30:7; Matt 24:21)
 - The two things to do when in trouble are: (1) turn to the Lord; and (2) be obedient to his voice (4:30)
 - Israel was sanctified in a 7-fold manner (4:34), by: (1) temptations; (2) signs; (3) wonders; (4) war; (5) a mighty hand; (6) a stretched out arm; and (7) great terrors
 - Keeping the commandments of the Lord leads to a PROSPEROUS and PROLONGED life (4:40)- a higher QUALITY of life and a higher QUANTITY of life cf. (Pro 3:1-2,16-17)
 - 4 things to do with the word of God (5:1): (1) hear it; (2) learn it; (3) keep it; and (4) do it
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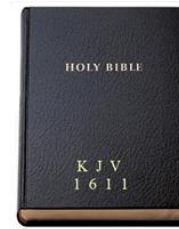

- The ten commandments are restated (5:6-21) cf. (Exo 20:1-17)
- I WILL SPEAK UNTO THEE ALL THE COMMANDMENTS (5:31)= this occurred in (Exo 20:22-32:7)
- GOD (6:4)= Heb. *Elohim*= plural (more than two in Hebrew), yet ONE Lord

9 Things To Do With The Words Of The Lord (6:6-9)

1. Put them in our heart (6:6)
 2. Teach them diligently to our children (6:7)
 3. Talk about them in our homes (6:7)
 4. Talk about them outside our homes (6:7)
 5. Talk about them in the evening (6:7)
 6. Talk about them in the morning (6:7)
 7. Hold them fast (6:8)
 8. Seek them (6:8)
 9. Display them (6:9)

- Apostasy begins in time of prosperity (6:10-12)
- OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (6:25)= the righteousness of God, which is necessary for salvation, is received by IMPUTATION; our righteousness is received by OBEDIENCE
