

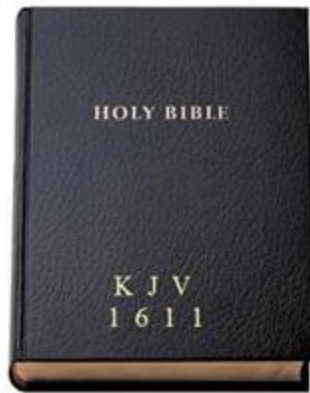

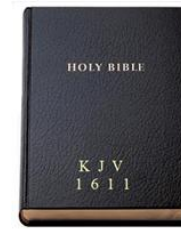

## THE CONDEMNATION OF ALL THINGS

**Genesis 6 = The World RIPENED For Judgment**

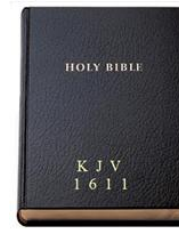
**Genesis 7 = The World RELINQUISHED To Judgment**

**Genesis 8-9 = The World RECOVERING From Judgment**

The “old world” (2 Pet 2:5) was not so different from this “present evil world” (Gal 1:4). In fact, the Lord Jesus indicated that the conditions of the world just prior to his Second Coming would be identical to those of the “world that then was” (2 Pet 3:6) just prior to the Flood (Luke 17:26-27).

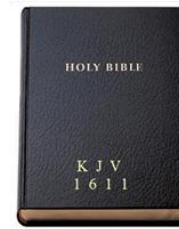


## Characteristics Of The Ante-Diluvian World

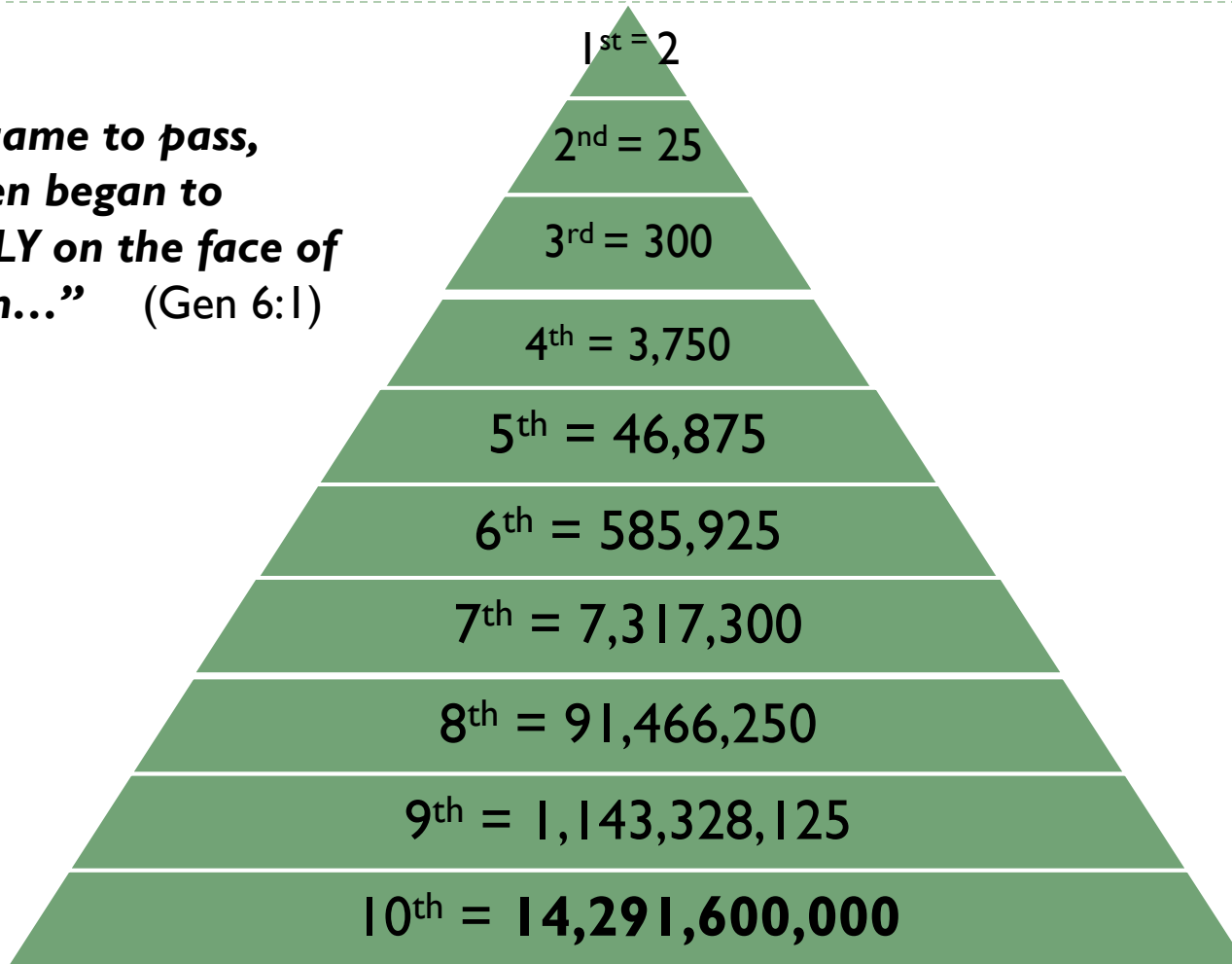
1. It was a **PROLIFIC** world- possibly 14 billion people
  - Average life span of 8 full generations in Gen 5 is 900 yrs
  - There are 10 generations from Adam to Noah
  - Each family had an average of 25 children (this equates to a child every 35 yrs, which is the same as each family today, with a life span of 70 yrs, having an average of 2 children)
  - Equal distribution of male and female children
2. It was a **PROGRESSIVE** world- possibly far advanced than today
  - The Chronological factor- men had 800-900 yrs to learn a skill or craft
  - The Geological and Biological factors- sin did not have as many years to take its toll on the earth and life as it has today
  - The “X” factor- an infusion of knowledge from extra-terrestrial beings
3. It was a **PERVERTED** world
  - “wicked” (v.5)
  - “evil” (v.5)
  - “corrupt” (v.11-12)
  - “violent” (v.11,13) Heb. *Smh* (pronounced “ Hamas ”)
  - “ungodly” (2 Pet 2:5; Jude 15)



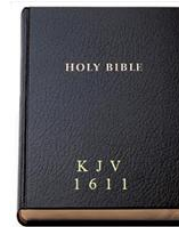

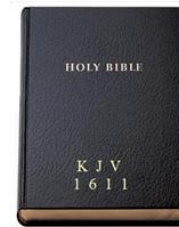


## Views regarding the identity of the “sons of God”

1. The godly line of Seth
  2. Fallen angels
- The correct view is that the “sons of God” are a class of **fallen angels**- this is clear from the use of the term elsewhere in the OT (Job 1:6; 2:1; 38:7), and NT passages describing what occurred (2 Pet 2:4; Jude 6)
  - *GIANT* = Heb. *lypN* (Nephil) = “fallen one; bully; tyrant; giant”

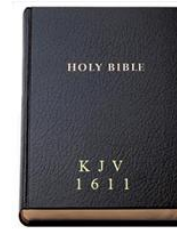

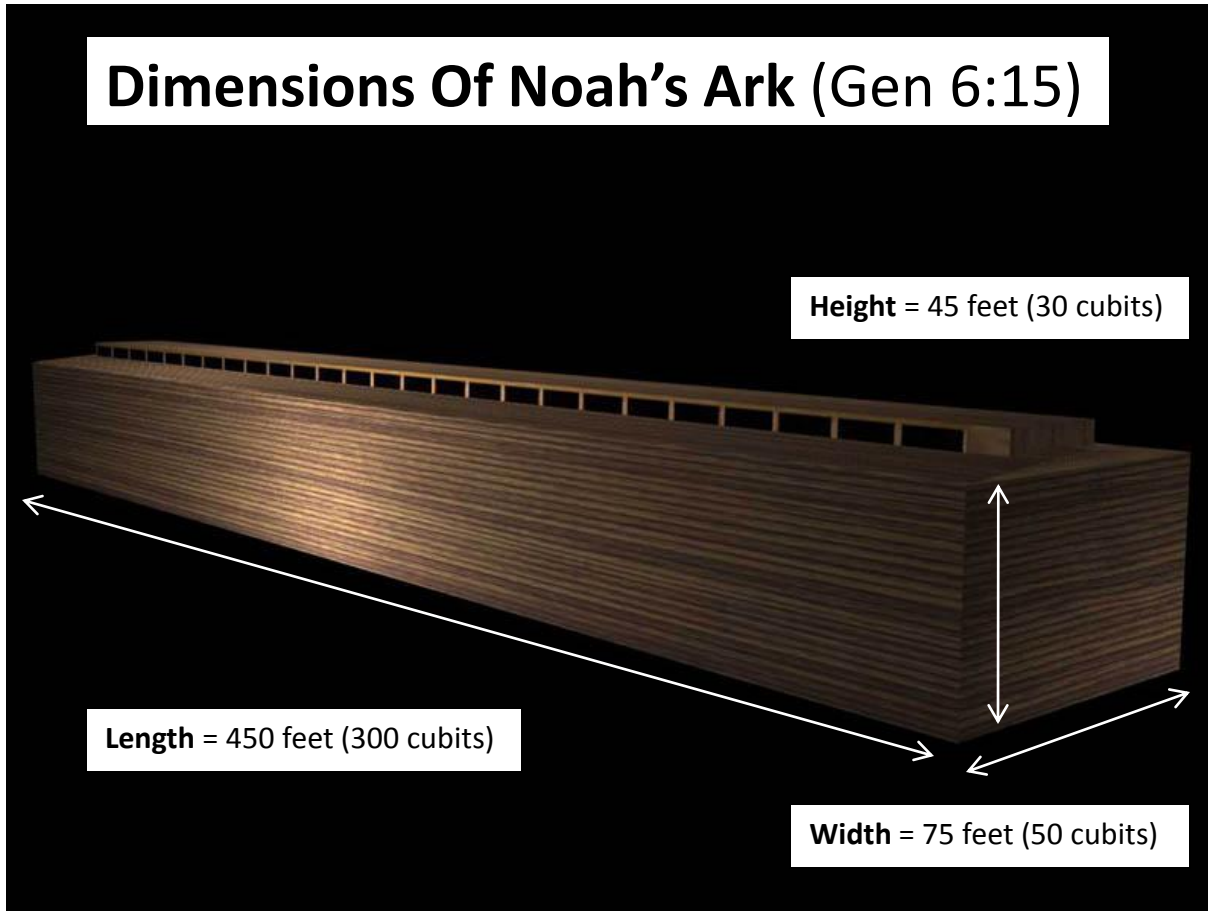

## Dimensions Of Noah's Ark (Gen 6:15)



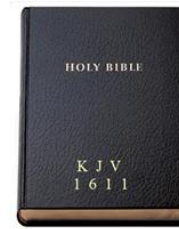
### NOTABLE FACTS ABOUT THE ARK

- There was a single window and door but no rudder, mast, or sail
- By comparing (5:32; 6:3; 7:11), Noah spent at least 20 years building the ark himself
- A total of 1,518,950 cubic feet
- Equivalent to 569 railroad cars and larger than a football field
- Enough room for 56,250 animals the size of a sheep, to occupy 27 cubic feet each
- Animals were of two of each unclean *kind* (sort not species) and seven pairs of each clean beast (it is estimated that there were no more than 2,000 *kinds* of animals at the time)
- Animals were air breathing- no fish
- Pairs of larger kinds of animals could have been young rather than adult
- The largest ship built by man until the Queen Mary in 1884





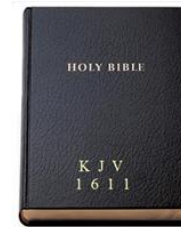

## Animal Classifications

1. Kingdom (e.g.- animal)
2. Phylum (e.g.- vertebrae)
3. Class (e.g.- mammal)
4. Order (e.g.- carnivore)
5. Family (e.g.- canine) “Family” is the same as “sort” or “kind”
6. Genus (e.g.- dog)
7. Species (e.g.- Golden Retriever)
