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Survey Of The Bible I

Genesis-Deuteronomy



Deu 28-31

- A six-fold blessing is promised if Israel is obedient to the word of God (28:1-6)
- The word IF appears 10x in (Deu 28-30) (28:1-2,9,13,15,58; 30:4,10,17)
- God's people are not promised immunity from CONFLICT (28:7), or even from CASUALTIES in conflict (20:5-7), but are promised CONQUEST over the enemy in the end
- ALL THE PEOPLE SHALL SEE (28:10)= the primacy of Israel above all nations will be fulfilled in the Millennium cf. (Zec 8:23)
- Those who promote the false teaching of the prosperity gospel use (28:11) as a proof text- an obedient Christian who puts the Lord first will have an abundant LIFE (John 10:10) but this does not necessarily equate to an abundance of RICHES cf. (1 Tim 6:6)
- A six-fold curse is promised if Israel is disobedient to the word of God (28:16-19), and this is followed by compounded judgments (28:20-68)
- THE LORD SHALL SMITE THEE (28:22)= the expression occurs 4x in the chapter (28:22,27-28,35) in conjunction with 16 different judgments
- FROM THE SOLE OF THY FOOT (28:35)= the suffering of Israel, particularly during the Tribulation, is typified by the suffering of JOB (Job 2:7)

- SONS AND DAUGHTERS...THOU SHALT NOT ENJOY THEM (28:41)= the Lord intended for us to enjoy our children; it is truly a curse to not be able to enjoy them, for whatever reason including a lack of time
 - All these curses were to come upon Israel, not only because of disobedience, but because of a lack of thankfulness and service to the Lord for his abundant blessings (28:45-47)- the USA has been blessed by the Lord like no other Gentile nation in all of history and we are reaping our lack of thankfulness to the Lord
 - A YOKE OF IRON...AS THE EAGLE FLIETH (28:48-49)= the former was fulfilled by the Babylonians and Romans; interestingly, Babylon, Rome, and Germany were all associated with IRON and the EAGLE
 - CANNIBALISM is one of the final forms of judgment and it is mentioned 3x in the chapter (28:53,55,57)
 - Yielding to sin and letting it rule our lives will lead to the unthinkable and unimaginable (28:56)
 - The judgment of (28:67) was partially fulfilled by the dispersion and will be completely fulfilled in the Tribulation (Luke 21:26)- typified by Job (Job 7:4)
 - THE COVENANT (29:1)= the Palestinian covenant
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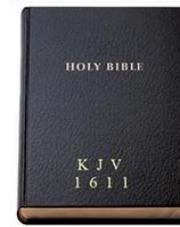

➤ **The Sixth Covenant: PALESTINIAN**

The Eight Great Covenants OfThe Bible

1. The EDENIC Covenant (Gen 1-2)
 2. The ADAMIC Covenant (Gen 3)
 3. The NOAHIC Covenant (Gen 9)
 4. The ABRAHAMIC Covenant (Gen 12; 13; 15; 17; 22)
 5. The MOSAIC Covenant (Exo 20-40)
 6. **The Palestinian Covenant (Deu 29-30)**
 7. The DAVIDIC Covenant (2 Sam 7)
 8. The NEW Covenant (Jer 31; Heb 8; 10)
- BLOT OUT HIS NAME FROM UNDER HEAVEN (29:20)= the tribes of DAN and Ephraim are not listed among the 144,000 (Rev 7:5-8) because both tribes apostasized (Jud 18; 19; Hos 4:17), and this judgment would fall on a TRIBE whose heart turned from the Lord (29:18)





Deu 28-31

- The four cities of the plain that were overthrown in judgment cf. (Gen 19:25) are: (1) Sodom; (2) Gomorrah; (3) Admah; and (4) Zeboim (29:23)- Zoar was the fifth city of the plain but it was spared for Lot's sake (Gen 19:21-22)
- THE SECRET THINGS (29:29) are the things God has chosen not to reveal, while THOSE THINGS WHICH ARE REVEALED are in the WORDS OF THIS LAW (i.e.- the word of God), and they are given that we may DO IT

Characteristics Of The Palestinian Covenant (30:1-9)

1. Israel to REAP for their disobedience (30:1)
2. Israel to REPENT while in dispersion (30:2)
3. The Lord to RETURN (30:3)
4. Israel to be REGATHERED to the land out of dispersion (30:3-5)
5. Israel to be REGENERATED nationally (30:6)
6. A RESTITUTION of the primacy and prosperity of Israel (30:7-9) cf. (Acts 3:21)
7. Israel to be a REJOICING (30:9)





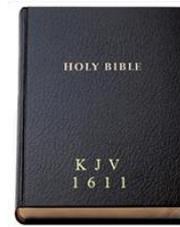
Deu 28-31

- The answer to the question, “**Where is the word of the Lord**”? (Jer 17:5), is found in (30:11-14), a passage on the perfect preservation of the word of God

The Perfect Preservation Of The Word Of God (30:11-14)

1. It is not hidden from us (i.e.- the Dead Sea scrolls; the “Bible Code”)
 2. It is not far off
 3. It is not in heaven that we need to go up there to get it
 4. It is not beyond the sea that we need to go over there to get it
 5. It is very near to us so we can hear it and do it
- This passage utterly dismisses the notions that the perfect and inspired word of God is: (1) hidden in some cave yet to be discovered; (2) only in heaven; and (3) only in a particular language
 - BRING IT UNTO US (30:12)= refers to THIS COMMANDMENT (30:11) and THE WORD (30:14)- in (Rom 10:6-8) it is applied to JESUS CHRIST
 - DO IT (30:14)= in order to DO it, we must HEAR it; in order to HEAR it, we must HAVE it





Deu 28-31

- CHOOSE LIFE (30:19)= the anti-abortion slogan; a person must CHOOSE to have eternal life by receiving Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, death is chosen by simply doing NOTHING
 - The Lord has a three-fold charge for his people, based on a three-fold promise, as they prepare to engage the enemy (31:6,8)
 - The three-fold charge is: (1) Be strong and of a good courage; (2) fear not; and (3) be not afraid of them
 - The three-fold promise is: (1) he will go with us and be with us; (2) he will not fail us; and (3) he will not forsake us
 - Exposing young children to the word of God will teach them the fear of the Lord (31:12-13)
 - The Lord tells Moses of the eventual apostasy of Israel (31:16)
 - The song of Moses (32:1-43) was given as a testimony against Israel in the day of their apostasy (31:21)
 - Moses wrote all of DEUTERONOMY (31:24) with the possible exception of (34:5-12), which could have been written by Joshua (Jos 24:26)
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
