

THE CONDEMNATION OF ALL THINGS


Genesis 6 = The World RIPENED For Judgment

Genesis 8-9 = The World RECOVERING From Judgment






“...were all the fountains of the great deep broken up” (v.11)

- The subterranean waters were under great pressure and were released by ruptures created by cataclysmic seismic activity






- Water, magma, and debris ejected out of the earth at super sonic speeds all along the rifts, possibly extending into and beyond the upper atmosphere, penetrating the vapor canopy- it is possible that some of the near earth orbit (NEO) objects are debris that was ejected at the time of the Flood
- Seismic activity under the ocean produced enormous tsunami waves that submerged large portions of land








“...the windows of heaven were opened” (v.11)

- As the ejected water and debris penetrated the vapor canopy, nucleation occurred- the vapor condensed and precipitated along with the ejected water
- The rock and debris ejected into the atmosphere fell back to the earth like meteorites
- If there were any changes to the earth’s electro-magnetic field at this time, additional meteorites may have fallen to the earth
- A massive crater beneath the ocean surface in the Yucatan Peninsula, Mexico serves as geological evidence that an “extinction level” asteroid or meteor impacted the earth sometime in the past
- It is possible that this impact occurred as part of the judgment of the Flood, but not necessarily as an asteroid or meteor from space
- The impact object could have been part of the material ejected from the earth when the fountains of the great deep were broken up, that fell back to the earth



“Calculations have been made, demonstrating that major disruption of the “fountains of the great deep” below Earth’s granite crust would send jets of steamy water ten to seventy miles high. These jets of steam would be sufficient to rip the canopy and open “windows” in its crystalline lattice, collapsing its structure in the forty-day timeline given in Scripture. The greater volume of water, however, would be expunged from the internal “fountains of the great deep,” along with vast deposits of internal elements. This eruption of elements and water continued for 150 days, providing material and mechanism for the global sedimentary deposits.” – Dr. Carl Baugh, Creation Evidence Museum




- As the waters quickly accumulated, life made for higher ground- the smaller and swifter animals would have been successful, while the larger and slower animals would not
- This explains the general fossil distribution as it is today (i.e.- birds, small mammals, and marine life found in mountain sides; dinosaurs found in valley beds)
- Since all the high hills and mountains, that were under the whole heaven were covered (v.19-20), the Flood had to reach at least a depth of over 29,050 feet to cover what we know today as Mt. Everest
- Since the rain fell for 40 days and 40 nights (v.12), it fell at an average rate of: 726.25 feet per day; 30.26 feet per hour; 6.06 inches per minute; 1 inch every 10 seconds
- If there were between 7 and 14 billion people before the Flood (including giants), where are all the remains/fossils?

NOTE: Most, if not all, the remains of the beings and buildings of the old world are under the OCEAN (Rev 20:13). A portion of the remains are what we know as OIL.

- Imagine what people thought when the earth quaked for the first time in history the fountains of the great deep began to be broken up
- As the waters quickly accumulated, some probably banged on the ark screaming for Noah to let them in- Noah and his family could hear the dying screams of those condemned to judgment
- The Lord could have caused the animals to hibernate for most of the time on the ark
- There is no mention of FEAR on the ark, although there had to be MANY instances of it, because there was no need to fear- to abide IN THE ARK was to abide in the protection and promise of God; the ark is a type of Christ
